



After the huge success of last year's inaugural Irish Champions Weekend, September sees the return of the ultimate Irish racing fixture.

Last year's meeting was a huge success, attracting over 24,000 spectators over both days. This year's event promises to be even better, with over €4million in prize money up for grabs.

Watch the action unfold at **Leopardstown** on **Saturday 12th September** and the **Curragh** on **Sunday 13th September**. Over the course of the weekend, 10 Group races will be run, including **five Group 1** contests, attracting some of the leading horses in Europe.

The feature race on the first day at Leopardstown is the **QIPCO Irish Champion Stakes** where dual Guineas winner, **Gleneagles** is a potential runner up in trip, along with Royal Ascot hero **Free Eagle**. The feature race the following day from the Curragh is the **Palmerstown House Estate Irish St Leger**, won last year by high class stayer **Brown Panther**, sparking wild celebrations in the winners' enclosure. It was another triumph for a British raider, paying further testament to the ability of the meeting to attract top-class runners from the other side of the Irish Sea.
